- You can nominate yourself for **up to TWO** positions, a main and a backup. Having a backup is not essential.
- Nominate yourself through the **Google Form** available in our bio from Saturday 21st February. You must apply by the **deadline** of Saturday 28th February for your nomination to be valid.
- You **MUST** be a PPE SOCIETY **member** to run and vote in elections. Thankfully, membership is **free!** This must be purchased by Tuesday 24th February and we will be checking at the door
- You will need one speech **PER POSITION**.
- You are **not** allowed to mention any other candidate in your speech.

- Speeches for BIG 3/BIG 4 (President, VP & Treasurer (potentially two roles), and Secretary), will be **2.5 minutes** long and you will be asked **2 questions** by existing exec members.
- Speeches for all other roles will be **1 minute** long, followed by **1 question**.
- You **cannot** wear your society Q-zip during the election
- **No** current exec members will be allowed to openly endorse any candidates
- If you are unable to attend elections, but want to run, please **DM** us.
- Voting will be done through paper ballot and **only in-person votes** will count.
